Teacher Effectiveness Draws Attention of Educators, Lawmakers

Teacher effectiveness promises to be a high-profile topic at the state Capitol this week, and Pennsylvania Partnerships for Children will be lending its voice to the discussion.

On Thursday, Nov. 3, the House Education Committee will host a public hearing on teacher evaluations – an important tool in promoting teacher effectiveness – and PPC President and CEO Joan Benso will be among those testifying.

The House hearing follows the **Making the Grade: Virtual Town Hall Meeting on Effective Teaching**, scheduled for 7 to 9 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 1, at an intermediate unit near you.

The virtual town hall will feature a panel discussion led by Pennsylvania Education Secretary Ron Tomalis and other education leaders who are at the forefront of the Commonwealth's efforts to improve teacher evaluations and boost effective teaching.
