






Children more likely to be uninsured by race/ethnicity



An index of 1.0 indicates no disproportionality. Bars to the left of 1.0 indicate underrepresentation, meaning the uninsured rates are lower than expected.






Enrollment in Publicly Funded or Supported Health Insurance (September 2023)








Medicaid Unwinding Data: Under 21 years
